

Subject: Appeal of Maharaja's Institute of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram u/s 35 (5) of NMC Act 2019 against PGMEB letter dated 04.12.2023 regarding reduction of annual intake capacity in the course of MS (General Surgery) from existing ten (10) to nine (09) seats for A.Y. 2024-25 – regarding.

The Appeal Committee, under the Chairmanship of Dr. B.N. Gangadhar, Chairman, NMC met on 2nd & 3rd April 2024 from 10:00 A.M onwards to consider the above appeal of Maharaja's Institute of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram as cited at subject matter.

2. The Appeal committee heard Maharaja's Institute of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram virtually and taken into consideration the submissions made by Principal/Dean in his defense.

3. Discussion points of 1st Appeal Committee


The facts presented to the 1st Appeal committee were examined carefully and views of Dean/Principal, Maharaja's Institute of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram were heard. After the detailed deliberation, it was observed the college had submitted the applications for recognition of MS (General Surgery) for A.Y. 2022-2023 to PGMEB.

- Physical inspection of the college was conducted by Medical Assessment & Rating Board (MARB) on 18th May, 2023.
- Based on the inspection report, PGMEB sent a compliance letter to college on 3rd August, 2023 pointing out a deficiency that the AEBAS report that none of the faculty is present for 50 per cent of the working days.
- Maharaja's Institute of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram vide its reply dated 2nd September, 2023 submitted a compliance report informing that they have subsequently improved.
- The Principal/Dean, Maharaja's Institute of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram agreed that faculty is deficient and inadequate at the time of inspection held in the A.Y. 2022-23.

- v. The committee noticed that none of the faculty is present for 50 per cent of the working days as per the AEBAS report and based on this deficiency, the college was not eligible for existing number of seats and the reduction was done accordingly.

5. Decision of 1st Appeal Committee

- i. The appeal committee discussed the matter in detail and was of unanimous view that the order of PGMEB issued by Letter No **35/259(107)/2022-PGMEB/059056-061** dated 04.12.2023 of granting renewal of recognition to only 09 seats and permitting admission for only 09 seats in respect of MS (General Surgery) at Maharaja's Institute of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram in the year 2024-25 is in order as there is gross deficiency of faculty and Senior Residents in the Department of General Surgery which were inadequate for 10 seats of MS (General Surgery) and Dean / Principal of the Institute also accepted this fact during virtual hearing. Therefore, college will admit only 09 seats for the academic year 2024-25. However, for the subsequent year i.e., 2025-26, Medical college have to submit annual disclosure/self- declaration as required under MSMER 2023 whenever, such applications invited by the concern boards and action as per MSMER 2023 will be taken by the concern Board. Appeal committee after detailed discussion, upheld the decision of PGMEB.
- ii. Maharaja's Institute of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram may prefer second appeal to the Ministry under Section 35 (7) of the National Medical Commission Act 2019 within 30 days of issuance of this order if the Institute so desires.



3. The Appeal committee heard Maharajah's Institute of Medical Sciences, Nellimarla virtually and taken into consideration the submissions made by Principal/Dean in their defense.

4. Discussion points of 1st Appeal Committee

The facts presented to the 1st Appeal committee were examined carefully and views of Dean, Maharajah's Institute of Medical Sciences, Nellimarla were heard. After the detailed deliberation, it was observed the college had submitted the applications for recognition of MD (Paediatrics) for A.Y. 2022-2023 to PGMEB.

- Physical inspection of the college was conducted by Medical Assessment & Rating Board (MARB) on 18th May, 2023.
- Based on the inspection report, PGMEB sent a compliance letter to college on 21st August, 2023 pointing out a deficiency of 02 Assistant Professors and 03 Senior Residents as per the AEBAS report.
- Maharajah's Institute of Medical Sciences, Nellimarla vide its reply dated 20th September, 2023 submitted a compliance report informing that they have subsequently improved.

- iv. The Principal/Dean, Maharajah's Institute of Medical Sciences, Nellimarla agreed that the faculty and Senior Residents were found inadequate at the time of inspection held in the A.Y. 2022-23.
- v. The committee noticed that there is deficiency of faculty i.e., two Assistant Professors and Three Senior Residents in the department of Paediatrics, which is not adequate to train the post graduate students studying in the medical college and based on this deficiency, the college was not eligible for existing number of seats and the reduction was done accordingly.

5. Decision of 1st Appeal Committee

- i. The appeal committee discussed the matter in detail and was of unanimous view that the order of PGMEB issued by Letter No **35/259(135)/2022-PGMEB/000222-27** dated **02.01.2024** of granting renewal of recognition to only 06 seats and permitting admission for only 06 seats in respect of MD (Paediatrics) at Maharajah's Institute of Medical Sciences, Nellimarla in the year 2024-25 is in order due to deficiency of faculty in the Department of Paediatrics, which was inadequate for 08 seats of MD (Paediatrics) and Dean / Principal of the Institute also accepted this fact during virtual hearing. Therefore, college will admit only 06 seats for the academic year 2024-25. However, for the subsequent year i.e., 2025-26, Medical college have to submit annual disclosure/self- declaration as required under MSMER 2023 whenever, such applications invited by the concern boards and action as per MSMER 2023 will be taken by the concern Board. Appeal committee after detailed discussion, upheld the decision of PGMEB.
- ii. Maharajah's Institute of Medical Sciences, Nellimarla may prefer second appeal to the Ministry under Section 35 (7) of the National Medical Commission Act 2019 within 30 days of issuance of this order if the Institute so desires.



The committee noticed that there is non-implementation of AEBAS and deficiency of faculty which is not adequate to train the post graduate students studying in the medical college and based on this deficiency, the college was not eligible for existing number of seats and the reduction was done accordingly.

5. Decision of 1st Appeal Committee

- i. The appeal committee discussed the matter in detail and was of unanimous view that the order of PGMEB issued by Letter No **35/259(94)/2022-PGMEB/062291-96** dated **29.12.2023** of granting renewal of recognition to only 13 seats and permitting admission for only 13 seats in respect of MD (Radiodiagnosis) at Maharajah's Institute of Medical Sciences, Nellimarla in the year 2024-25 is in order as there is non-implementation of AEBAS and deficiency of faculty in the Department of Radiodiagnosis, which was inadequate for 15 seats of MD (Radiodiagnosis) and Dean / Principal of the Institute also accepted this fact during virtual hearing. Therefore, college will admit only 13 seats for the academic year 2024-25. However, for the subsequent year i.e., 2025-26, Medical college have to submit annual disclosure/self-declaration as required under MSMER 2023 whenever, such applications invited by the concern board and action as per MSMER 2023 will be taken by the concern Board. Appeal committee after detailed discussion, upheld the decision of PGMEB.
- ii. Maharajah's Institute of Medical Sciences, Nellimarla may prefer second appeal to the Ministry under Section 35 (7) of the National Medical Commission Act 2019 within 30 days of issuance of this order if the Institute so desires.
