## Department of Anatomy

The Department of Anatomy under the guidance of Dr Neelima.P launched the innovative "Healing Arts" program on 16 March 2026. Faculty members actively participated in the Faculty Development Program (FDP) organized by the Medical Education Unit (MEU), MIMS.

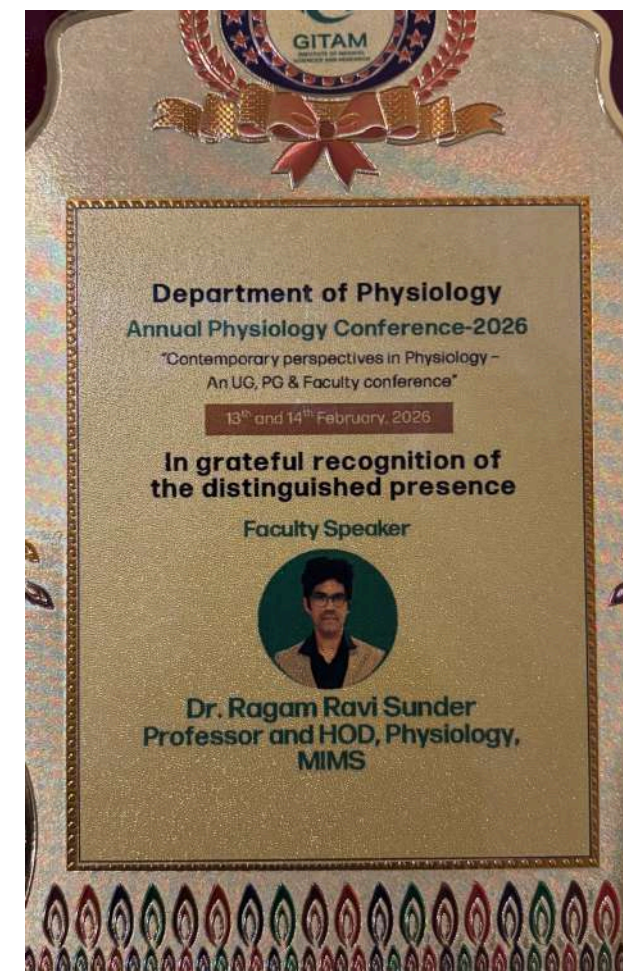
Faculty Achievements:

Dr. Ravi Sunder Ragam, Professor & Head of the Department, Principal, Allied Medical Sciences has attended and delivered a guest lecture at the Annual Physiology State Conference held at GIMSR, Visakhapatnam on 13–14 February 2026.

Topic: Books, Clocks & Calm Minds: MBBS Exam Mastery

Dr. R. Havilah Twinkle, Professor has attended the International Medical Education Conference at Christian Medical College (CMC), Vellore on 9, 10 & 11 January 2026.

She has also attended the Annual Physiology Conference 2026 held at GIMSR, Visakhapatnam on 13–14 February 2026.



### Department of Biochemistry

From January to March 2026, the Department of Biochemistry at MIMS, Vizianagaram, strengthened its academic and translational research profile through two notable international publications, by Dr DSSK Raju, Professor Of Biochemistry, in EMBASE-indexed original article on the interplay of serum TNF- $\alpha$ , vitamin D, and carotid intima-media thickness across different stages of chronic kidney disease, and a Medline-, Scopus- and EMBASE-indexed paper on lumbar spine DEXA findings in Indian males with osteoporosis, in which departmental faculty contributed as first and second authors; together, these works underscore the department's growing role in integrating biochemical markers with clinical risk stratification in nephrology and metabolic bone disease.

## Department of Microbiology

Academic research was a key highlight for the department, particularly the contributions of Dr. B. Prema Nandhini, Associate Professor. During this quarter, she authored two significant peer-reviewed publications:

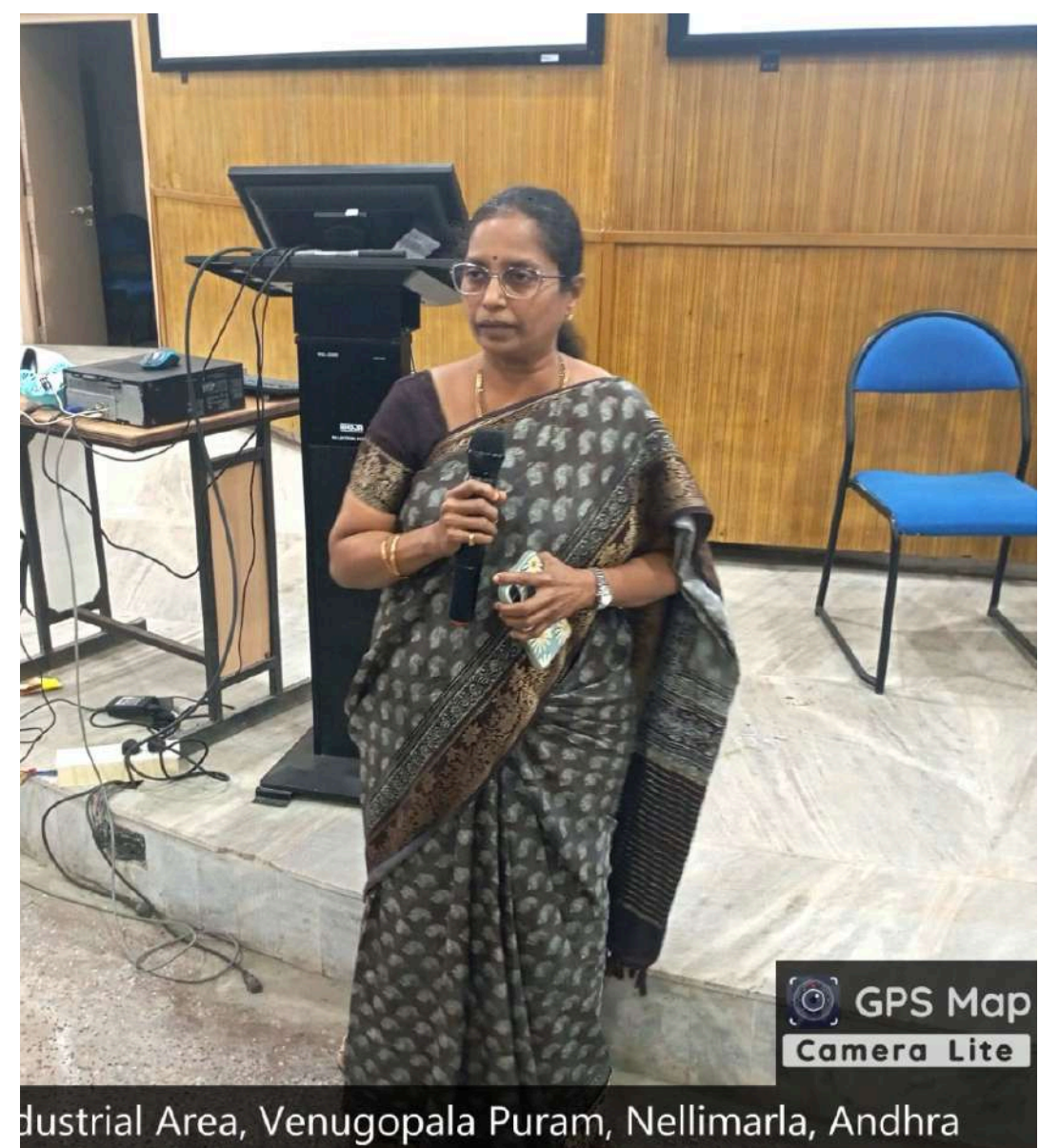
1. A study on dengue epidemiology published in the Journal of Carcinogenesis, analyzing 2,000 cases to identify seasonal clusters and age-specific burdens.
2. Research on vulvovaginal candidiasis, published in 2026, which identified high culture positivity and significant azole resistance, emphasizing the need for species-level identification.



## Department of Pathology

The Department of Pathology at MIMS maintained a high trajectory of academic and faculty development throughout the first quarter of 2026. Under the leadership of Dr. B. V. Madhavi, Professor and Head, the department prioritized modern educational methodologies by participating in specialized Faculty Development Programmes, including "Cracking the OSCE/OSPE Code" in January and "Art of Reflective Writing and Critical Thinking" in February. Dr. Madhavi also extended the department's influence into interdisciplinary forums by representing MIMS as a Delegate and Faculty at the AP Midterm Conference of the Association of Radiation Oncologists of India in Visakhapatnam.

Beyond traditional academics, the department demonstrated a unique commitment to the "Healing Arts," bridging the gap between science and creativity. During the HISTOLI and PoetAnat celebrations on March 16, Dr. Divya Posarla contributed original poetry regarding human anatomy. Both Dr. Posarla and Dr. Madhavi served as judges for these events,

## Clinical Departments – Major Highlights

### Department of Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy

The department maintained stellar academic momentum, highlighted by active participation in DERMACON 2026 in Bengaluru.

Faculty and residents presented the following notable contributions:

Dr. Rajani Chandika: Delivered an Oral Free Paper on the efficacy of microneedling, oral tranexamic acid, and modified Kligman's formula in Melasma.

Dr. Kyadiga Sowmya: Presented an E-Poster on microneedling fractional \$CO\_2\$ laser and PRP in striae atrophicans.

Dr. Vaddarapu Anjana: Presented an E-Poster on clinicoepidemiological features and quality of life in psoriasis.

Dr. Sunkavalli Priyanka: Presented an E-Poster on vesiculobullous lesions as markers of systemic involvement in cutaneous small vessel vasculitis.

Dr. Mythri Jagannadham and Dr. V. Akila (Senior Resident) actively participated as delegates and in faculty development sessions.

The department also published four international case reports in the International Journal of Research in Dermatology. Authors included Dr. Vaddarapu Anjana, Dr. P. Sirisha, Dr. K.V.T. Gopal, Dr. P.V. Krishnam Raju, Dr. K. Sowmya, Dr. B. Rekha Rani, Dr. Sunkavalli Priyanka, and Dr. Rajani Chandika.

### Department of ENT

The ENT department focused on surgical skill enhancement and public health advocacy. Dr. M. Bindu secured the 2nd Prize in the 1st Temporal Bone Dissection Course held at Government Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada, on 2 February 2026. This intensive hands-on training is essential for advancing otological surgical expertise.

On 3 March 2026, the department observed World Hearing Day under the theme "From Communities to Classrooms: Hearing Care for Every Child". The team organized a vibrant awareness program, emphasizing early detection and intervention for hearing issues in children. Faculty, residents, and staff engaged with patients and students through interactive sessions and informative posters at the ENT OPD.

## Department of Psychiatry

Throughout the first quarter, the Department of Psychiatry focused on vital community mental health initiatives and preventive psychiatry. A cornerstone event was the EASE AP Suicide Prevention Peer Mentor Training held on March 9, 2026. Coordinated by Dr. G. Hemanth Madhav, Professor and Head, the program was designed to empower students with the skills for early identification of emotional distress and the establishment of robust peer support systems.

The department concurrently fostered a strong research culture among its students and faculty. Ongoing scholarly work has delved into contemporary issues such as nomophobia and social interaction anxiety among healthcare professionals, as well as interventions for stress and well-being among medical students. By investigating the links between screen time and executive function in young adults, the department continues to address the intersection of modern lifestyle and mental health, advancing holistic student support at MIMS.

## Department of General Surgery

The Department of General Surgery showcased commendable performance during the first quarter of 2026. In January, Dr. Srihita (PGY2) and the postgraduate team won 3rd Prize in the Antimicrobial Resistance Programme Quiz competitions held at MIMS, Vizianagaram and Nellimarla. The team also successfully operated a case of oral cavity malignancy involving hemiglossectomy, floor of mouth excision, modified neck dissection, and reconstruction with a forehead rotation flap under the guidance of Dr. Mythili (Professor), Dr. Kavya (SR), Dr. Ramya (PGY2), and Dr. Sanjay (PGY2).

In February, on World Cancer Day, the department conducted cancer awareness activities in the OPD and organized expert talks by Dr. R.V. Srinivas Rao (HOD & Professor) on “Breast Cancer Awareness” and “Cervical Cancer Awareness”. A rare case of gall bladder tuberculosis was managed with CBD exploration, cholecystectomy, segmental hepatic resection, and periportal dissection by Dr. R.V. Srinivas Rao, Dr. Livia (SR), Dr. Sreekar (PGY2), Dr. Ramya (PGY2), and Dr. Sashi (PGY1). In March, Dr. K.C.T. Naik (Medical Superintendent & Professor), Dr. Kavya (SR), and Dr. Sushma (PGY2) successfully performed hernioplasty with abdominal releasing incisions for a rare scrotal abdomen case. Additionally, Dr. Praneetha (Asst. Professor), Dr. Pawan (Asst. Professor), and Dr. Kavya (SR) completed the ACRI Course on Coloproctology and appeared for the FCRSI examination.

### The Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology

They had an academically vibrant first quarter of 2026, with faculty contributing significantly to both women's health research and high-risk pregnancy care. An observational study led by Dr. Sri Pavani Damera and colleagues documented a high burden of menstrual disorders among reproductive-age women, highlighting dysmenorrhea and heavy menstrual bleeding and underscoring links with modifiable factors such as obesity, sedentary lifestyle, stress, anemia, and PCOS, thereby emphasizing the need for early screening and integrated counseling at our tertiary centre. Complementing this, Dr. Naveena Pothala's team reported important clinicodemographic trends and maternal-fetal outcomes in hypertensive disorders of pregnancy, demonstrating that while gestational hypertension was most common, severe preeclampsia and eclampsia were associated with increased preterm birth, low birth weight, NICU admission, and maternal complications, reinforcing the department's focus on vigilant antenatal surveillance and timely referral to improve outcomes for mothers and babies in our region.



### Department of Paediatrics

The Paediatrics Department achieved significant national recognition at the 61st National Conference of the Indian Academy of Paediatrics (PEDICON 2026) held in Kolkata. A standout achievement was recorded by Dr. V. Lava Kumar, a final-year postgraduate, who secured 3rd place and a cash prize of Rs. 10,000 in the National Vaccinology Quiz conducted in association with Bharat Biotech. Additionally, Dr. Yasam Lavakumar presented a relevant poster investigating the immediate effects of smartphone exposure on the cognitive abilities of primary school children.

The department also showcased robust research contributions through various faculty-guided presentations. Dr. Panchabavi Prathyusha, under the guidance of Dr. Y. V. S. S. Murty, presented research on using neck circumference as a marker for childhood obesity. Furthermore, Mullapudi Subrahmanya Venkatesh, guided by Prof. B. Ch. Varma, presented an e-poster on the utility of the LATCH score in predicting breastfeeding success and weight gain in term babies. These accolades reflect the department's dedication to pediatric research and its consistent presence on the national stage.





### Department of General Medicine

Dr. Mouleeswara Kumar Tamma achieved a prestigious milestone by being provisionally shortlisted for the Diploma in Allergy and Asthma (DAA) at CMC Vellore, in collaboration with International Asthma Services, USA. This highly respected one-year program equips specialists to provide better diagnosis and management for the rising burden of allergic disorders in India.

Dr. Mouleeswara Kumar also served as a resource faculty for the MEU workshop on OSCE/OSPE, demonstrating a strong commitment to both clinical subspecialties and medical education.

### Department of Orthopedics

The Department of Orthopaedics, MIMS, had a productive academic quarter from January to March 2026, with active participation in OSSAPCON 2026 and multiple research publications by faculty and postgraduate residents. At the 55th Annual Conference of the Orthopaedic Surgeons Society of Andhra Pradesh, residents presented work on JESS fixation for metacarpal and phalangeal fractures and a case report on osteochondroma of the distal femur. Faculty and residents also published original studies on distal femur fracture fixation, MRI versus arthroscopy in meniscal injuries, and femoral fixation methods in ACL reconstruction, reinforcing the department's commitment to clinical excellence and academic growth.
